Postcode_Sector	The Postcode Sector (eg UB7 0)
Postcode_District	The Postcode District (eg UB7)
Postcode_Area	The Postcode Area (eg UB)
Health_Authority_Code	Strategic Health Authorities in England, Health Boards in Scotland, Health and Social Services Boards (HSSBs) in Northern Ireland, empty for Wales
Health_Authority_Name	Strategic Health Authorities in England, Health Boards in Scotland, Health and Social Services Boards (HSSBs) in Northern Ireland, empty for Wales
NHS_Region_Code	NHS Region in England plus Northern Ireland, Wales and Scotland
NHS_Region_Name	NHS Region in England plus Northern Ireland, Wales and Scotland

NHS Region & NHS Code

Administrative and health authority codes are those used by ONS. Allocation of Local Government codes to Postcode is by point-in-polygon comparison against Boundary-Line data, excluding Northern Ireland.

In the case of unitary authorities, no code is given for administrative county, the authority code appears as the district code.

The NHS codes are then determined from the County, District and Ward using data supplied by Office for National Statistics (ONS)

The NHS Code is a 3 character code indicating the Health Authority.

NHS codes for the Isle of Man (IM), Guernsey (GY) and Jersey (JE) now appear on Postzon. They are as follows:

IM = YAC

JE = YAD

GY = YAE

The NHS Region is a 3 character code indicating a Regional Office in England. Scotland, Northern Ireland and Wales do not have Regional Offices but have been allocated dummy codes.
